


Contact page

If you want your readers to contact you directly, you can add a contact page to your website. This theme includes built-in [Formsfree.io integration](#) for easy setup.

Add the contact page

1. Create a new page, add a page title, add an excerpt, and open the '**Page settings**' panel using the icon in the top right of the screen.
2. At the bottom of the panel you'll see a dropdown menu titled '**Template**'.
3. Use the dropdown menu to select the '**Contact**' template, close the panel.
4. Finally, click '**Publish**'.

Easy: Standard Contact Form

To simplify setup, we've pre-built a contact form into the contact page, featuring fields for Name, Email Address, and Message. You can enable this quickly and easily, even without any coding

knowledge.

Create a form on Formspree.io

1. Go to formspree.io and sign up for an account.
2. Once signed in, create a new form and obtain the endpoint URL for the form.

Add your Formspree endpoint

1. Navigate to '**Design & branding**' settings in the Ghost Admin.
2. Locate the "**Site wide**" tab on the right-hand side of the interface.
3. Navigate to the field labeled "**Contact form endpoint**" and toggle on or off the setting.
4. Paste your Formspree endpoint. e.g: `https://formspree.io/f/xeqylqgk`
5. To apply the modifications you've made, click the "**Save**" button.

Advanced: Custom Contact Form

If you prefer to use a custom contact form instead of the one included with the theme, you can do so without editing the theme files.

Important: This step is not required if you have set up the standard contact form.

Enable the custom contact form

1. Navigate to the contact page you have created
2. Open the '**Page settings**' panel using the icon in the top right of the screen.
3. In the tags field, add the internal tag `#custom_contact_form`

1. Go to your Formspree account and copy the form content from the "**HTML**" section.

2. Navigate back to the Ghost dashboard and open the Contact page.
3. Create an HTML card and paste the copied HTML code from Formspree.
4. Customize the form with your custom fields.
5. To apply the modifications you've made, click the **"Update"** button.

As long as you adhere to the format described above, the form submission will be processed through an AJAX request by default, preventing redirection to formspree.io after submission.

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
